To ensure that your child's **needs** can be met in a setting.

Their opportunities for development and progress are improved

Why

?

To ensure that parents and professionals share information and work in partnership.

They have a **positive** start to their Education.

There is a Statutory expectation and **Duty** to notify the Local Authority

Stages of what should happen

- Discussion between Health care professional & Parent/carer share their concerns
- 2) Support and information services available shared with parents
- 3) Consent to share? We can't just share can we?
- 4) Documentation completed (Form)
- 5) Submit Documents to NCC

A. Is child in a setting?

B. Is child in receipt of services i.e. Portage, Sensory support

C. Is child only known to health not in receipt of any educational support







What are NCC going to do with the information?


- Check child is in receipt of expected and entitled services
- Funding available if needed
- Monitor, provide information and support
- Share important information for Forward planning








Example of information from current notifications made











Awaiting Data for Numbers of children with SEND in schools to be accessed

- Percentage of children in mainstream education setting with no extra support
- Percentage of children in mainstream education setting with additional support
- Percentage of children in specialist settings
- (Could we have a triangle here?)





Messages from Parent/carers

- Leaflet for parents/carers?
- What information would you need?
- Example of draft leaflets?
- Is the information easily understood?
- What needs to change to improve understanding?
- Does the information provide what a parent needs to make a decision?
- Is there anything missing if so what else needs to be included?
- How would you feel if you were provided with this leaflet?
